WHAT LEVEL DO YOU COMPETE IN?

Youth: (Green class designation) Ages 11-16

Novice: (Red class designation) Beginning carvers who have carved for less than 4 years and have not won more than six (6) blue or red ribbons in the Novice Class.

Intermediate: (Yellow class designation) Those carvers who have carved for four (4) years or more, and who have won less

than six (6) blue and/or red ribbons in the Intermediate Class in previous years.

Open: (blue class designation) All other carvers entering competition.

Entering carvings in competition has an added benefit of providing additional carving on display for the viewing pleasure of the general public. It is not all about winning or losing.

Consider entering several pieces to support your club.


BUSINESS CARDS ANYONE?
